From the Pastor

God's Word

I watched a video* on YouTube where some Christians in China open a couple suitcases and inside are Bibles. Their reaction is amazing. Some kiss these books, some shed tears, all kind of cheer and many dive right in, opening it, reading it. Joy. That's the only word to describe it. Pure delight at having God's word in their own language available to them.

I sit at my desk typing this and I have at least a half dozen Bibles within arm's reach and possibly every language and every variation is available to me via the internet – since we live in a country where the government does not censor our internet access. I appreciate the Bible. I devote myself to reading and studying Go's word. But joy? Hmmm....

Psalm 119 says:

I meditate on your precepts
and consider your ways.
I delight in your decrees;
I will not neglect your word. (15-16)

What I loved seeing in that video was people who evidenced with their very lives how important God's word is to them. Because they never had full access before, now they do. I heard a pastor from an African country that has a very powerful Muslim presence, where the Bible in printed form is an immediate prison sentence or worse, tell us that his church members each memorized a book of the Bible (or part of one) and when he needed to preach, he would ask that person to stand up and recite the passage. Imagine the joy they would have if someone put the Bible in their hands, in their language, and said, "This is yours to read whenever you want." Delight. Joy.

Delight in God's decrees.

How's our delight quotient?

There was a time in my life when I did neglect God's word, when I would let the urgency of the day crowd out the importance of spending time with God. It was not a good time in my life. I had nothing but my own ideas and some vague memories of right and wrong to guide me. I assumed that I lived a "good" life, and that's really all that God wanted, right? And I would use all the excuses – too busy, not enough time, things at my house are too loud, and on and on. But where was my grounding? Now, don't get me wrong, I still have my days where I hit the ground running with the thought that "I'll get to it later"... but I never do on those days. But I hit far more than I miss now. And God's word is more than just words – these are, as the disciples said to Jesus – the words of eternal life (John 6).

Take ten or fifteen minutes a day and read. Soak in. Delight in God's word. If you've never really read the Bible before, start with a Gospel (Mark is the shortest one ☺) and just read a chapter a day. Read the four Gospels, then the Book of Acts, then Romans. Hear the words that Jesus actually said, see the things he actually did, understand the depth of God's love and grace for us, watch as the church is born in the hearts of just a handful of people and then how it spreads, and even the enemies of God come to salvation. And enjoy it.



HELP NEEDED FOR LOVE INC

Warren Grace UMC agreed a year ago to be in partnership with LOVE INC (Love In The Name Of Christ) of Warren County. The poor and those in difficult life situations can call LOVE INC to make their concerns known, and LOVE INC acts as a clearing house or contact center for the many churches in Warren County who actually meet the individual's needs.

Each caller is interviewed on the phone with a series of questions. After an evaluation of the caller's interview, LOVE INC refers the person to one or more of the churches that can provide for some or all of the person's needs. These can include food, clothing, furniture, baby supplies, linens and towels, transportation, financial counseling, etc.

As part of our responsibility as a church in partnership with LOVE INC, Grace UMC needs to provide a volunteer liaison between the church and the organization. This person would attend one meeting every two months, relate to our congregations the progress and potential needs of LOVE INC, and communicate to LOVE INC the services that we at Grace could supply (i.e. our food pantry).

LOVE INC also needs one or two volunteers to work at the call center (at 29 Railroad St., Youngsville) 3-4 hours per week or every two weeks. (The 3-4 hours would all be on one day.) There is a written set of questions to ask the caller. Neither of these volunteer positions is hard. There is a brief training period before beginning as a volunteer at the call center or as Grace Church's liaison to LOVE INC.

The mission of "Love In The Name Of Christ" is to bring together churches in our area to extend a hand up, not a hand out, to people in difficult situations by drawing alongside them to discover what their deeper needs are; by praying with them and for them; by inviting them to church, and by sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. For Grace Church, it is an opportunity for Christian outreach and witness in Warren County. It is a chance to know Christ and to make Him known.

Please prayerfully consider whether you may be receiving a call from our Lord Jesus Christ to serve your church and your community as a liaison or call center worker. Even if this is not for you, pray

that people from Grace UMC will emerge to fill these vacancies soon.
