From the Pastor

Straight to the Heart

We are beginning a new worship series on May 1st: The Heart of the Matter.

Over the next six weeks we are going to explore what our church leadership has identified as the five Core Values of Grace Church.

Now, before I talk about these specific five core values, let me make a couple of things clear.

First, our Purpose (the greater mission) has never changed: To Know Christ and to Make Him Known. That comes to us from the Great Commission in Matthew 28, and it is our expression of the purpose of the Church Universal.

Second, there are lots of things that are core to being a church, that are what we might call “permission to play” values. Take, for example, the Apostles’ Creed. It’s a given that if we are a Christian Church, we believe in God – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – in the Communion of Saints, forgiveness of sins, etc. That should be common to all Christian Churches. Love God and love your neighbor. Core to all. Jesus is the Way the Truth and the Life. Core to all. Our goal was to identify five Core Values that are expressed uniquely here at Grace Church.

Hopefully you’ve seen our Core Values on slides before and after worship or in the bulletin. They’ve been posted on our website and Embrace Grace Facebook page for a few weeks now too.

YHWH

There was a moment when Moses dared to ask God what his name was. God was gracious enough to answer and the name He gave, in Hebrew, was YHWH. Overtime, we arbitrarily added an “a” and an “e” to get YaHWeH, presumably because we have a preference for vowels!



But, scholars and Rabbis have noted that the letters YHWH represent breathing sounds, or aspirated consonants. When pronounced without intervening vowels, it actually sounds like breathing:

YH (inhale) WH (exhale)

So, a baby’s first cry, his first breath, speaks the name of God. A deep sigh calls His name – or a groan or a gasp that is too heavy for mere words.

Even an atheist would speak His name, unaware that their very breath is giving constant acknowledgment to God. Likewise, a person leaves this earth with their last breath, when God’s name is no longer filling their lungs. So, when I can’t utter anything else, is my cry calling out His name?

Being alive means I speak His name constantly. So, is it heard the loudest when I am the quietest?

In sadness, we breathe heavy sighs. In joy, our lungs feel almost like they will burst. In fear, we hold our breath and have to be told to breathe slowly to help us calm down. When we’re about to do something hard, we take a deep breath to find our courage.

When I think about it, breathing is giving him praise. Even in the hardest moments!

This is so beautiful and fills me with emotion every time I grasp the thought. God chose to give himself a name that we can’t help but speak every moment we are alive. All of us, always, everywhere: waking, sleeping, breathing with the name of God on our lips.

THEIR MISSION IS:

To build ramps onto the homes of those in need as an active demonstration and expression of the love of Jesus.

This is a group of everyday folks, (no building experience necessary), who have a passion to help others. They provide all of the labor and materials necessary for completing a ramp for those in need, design and install semi-permanent ramps that can be relocated if the recipient moves or no longer needs the ramp. They do not charge a fee to build a ramp, however, families are asked to evaluate for themselves their ability to contribute to the project.

To get involved with this group, just sign up and give us your phone number. When a ramp is planned, you will receive a "robo call" from the coordinator with all the information and you just show up to help! There are several other ways to get involved without building...
