From the Pastor

Passion

was reading an article the other day by Sam Rainer called "The One Unexpected Question that Reveals the Heart of Your Church." Sam and his father Thom are church consultants who have worked with hundreds (probably thousands) of churches over the years so I'm always interested in their insights into church culture, most of which come from asking questions and then simply listening to what people say. According to Sam, the question that gets people talking more than any other is:

"What gets your church most excited?" or "What gets you most excited about your church?"

What's important about the question is that it draws out positive answers. We can all find things about the Church and about our church that need work, that are wrong, that should have been retired two generations ago – but what makes this question a good question for every church member to consider is that it looks forward instead of backward.

So what gets you excited about church?

And, like a good pastor, Sam illustrates his point with four subpoints that all begin with the letter "P".

The answer we give to the question reveals:

Passion – what excites us about church is what moves us and makes us want to continue
Priority – what excites us about church is what we build on and make a focus of our church
Perspective – what excites us about church moves us in a positive direction
Personality – what excites us about church reveals the part of Jesus' mission that is at the heart of the church: some churches are generous, some are welcoming, some have amazing music, some have deep theology, there are as many church personalities as there are churches.

The Apostle Paul wrote a lot about what it is to be The Church, the Body of Christ. In Galatians chapter 6 Paul encourages us to "bear one another's burdens" (6:2) and the warning that "whatever a person sows, this he will also reap." (6:7) But in all of this, he is encouraging the Church, and encouraging us, to lean into what gets us excited about the church – about *our* church, Grace Church:

Let's not become discouraged in doing good, for in due time we will reap, if we do not become weary. So then, while we have opportunity, let's do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith. (6:9-10)

So... what gets you excited about Grace Church?

That's not a rhetorical question, I'd really like to hear what you have to say.

Psalm 103:13
