From the Pastor

Beauty for Ashes

was meeting with a group of pastors and someone commented that Ash Wednesday is on Valentine's Day this year which led to a lot of goofy comments (someone said they'd use a chocolate fountain instead of ashes this year). But then the talk got a little more serious. There's a certain appropriateness in celebrating the beginning of the season of Lent on a day that we have set aside to celebrate love.

Early in Jesus' ministry, he traveled to his hometown of Nazareth and he read from the Isaiah scroll part of Isaiah 61 (Luke 4:16-30):

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord..."

And, as you read the Gospel of Luke, Jesus sat down and said, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." And the religious leaders and the people accused Jesus of blasphemy... a tense and uncertain moment in Jesus' ministry.

But the words of the Prophet Isaiah are *supposed* to be fulfilled in our hearing – in our reading – in our living. We are empowered by God to bring the hope of salvation to the people.

That's part of why I think it is so appropriate that Ash Wednesday is on the secular day of celebrating love: everything we are and do is to be motivated by love – by true, godly, unconditional love. We love, John tells us, because God first loved us.

And so the ashes of Ash Wednesday are an "outward and visible sign" of the inner working of God's love in our lives. Ashes represent our repentance, our willingness to be transparent and vulnerable before God and release all our hurts and our troubles and our resentments and our obsessions.

Jesus stopped reading after the first phrase of verse 2 of Psalm 61. The rest of verse 2 and verse 3 say:

"...to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified."

I don't know about anybody else, but I want to go to the beauty, the oil of joy, the garment of praise right away. But the promise is that God makes beauty from ashes, joy from mourning, praise from heaviness. The season of Lent – the six weeks before Easter – is a season of examining our lives and our relationships and our

faith and pouring all that we are out before God – who trades beauty for ashes, joy for mourning, and praise for heaviness. But the ashes and mourning and heaviness cannot be bypassed for all of this is part of the human condition, a legacy of original sin. And because we mourn and struggle and sin, God responds to us in perfect love to make something beautiful and hopeful and live giving in our lives through Jesus, the atoning sacrifice for our sin and our brokenness.

Beauty for ashes...

So celebrate Valentine's Day with those you love, and with the One who loves you enough to die for you.
